NORFOLK

I am providing this BEAD Letter of Intent to notify the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) that the Southside Network Authority (SNA) will be submitting an application for the Broadband Equity, Access, and Development Program (BEAD).

PORTSMOUTH

The SNA was formed by the five Southside cities of Chesapeake, Norfolk, Portsmouth, Suffolk, and Virginia Beach with the goal of developing a state-of-the-art Fiber Optic Network that would connect the entire 757 region. The 119-mile fiber ring named the Regional Connectivity Ring (RCR), will serve as the backbone of 757's current and future digital ecosystem.

SUFFOLK

To ensure success of the RCR network, the SNA has made strategic partnerships to facilitate network completion. With over 50 years of experience in installing and maintaining the nation's infrastructure, Danella Construction was selected to be the contractor for the construction of the Southside ring. Columbia Telecommunications Corporation (CTC) was selected to design and conduct project management duties of the middle-mile network based on their over 30 years of experience in IT engineering consulting. To facilitate last-mile connectivity, SNA formed a P3 partnership with Global Technical Systems (GTS). GTS is a local Defense Technology Contractor, with a long history of providing secure network connectivity to the United States Government and is committed to providing broadband service to the unserved, underserved, and community anchor institutions.

VIRGINIA BEACH

The SNA intends to seek federal funding for last-mile connectivity to unserved, underserved, and disadvantaged neighborhoods as well as community anchor institutions located in the Hampton Roads region. Applications may be regional in nature or city-specific for our member cities.
